

Veer Towers Celebrates Return of Las Vegas Luxury Condo Market

On June 20, 2013, more than 500 guests descended upon Veer Towers for a lavish celebration highlighting the luxury condos.

The towers were designed by world-famous Murphy/Jahn Architects of Chicago and lean across each other at a 5 degree angle, glistening in gold day and night.
